

SAFETY'RULES'

- Treat all firearms as if they are loaded at all times.
- Always keep the muzzle of your weapon pointed in a "safe direction". Within the Centralia Rifle Range, this is "downrange".
- Keep your finger off the trigger until you are ready to fire.
- Always keep your weapon unloaded until you are told to load by the Range Safety Officer, or until you are on the firing line and ready to fire.
- Eye and ear protection must be worn by all persons on the range, including spectators and visitors.
- Follow the orders of the Range Officer. If no range officer is present, informal groups of shooters should select a person to control their shooting activities.
- No intoxicating substances, nor persons under the influence of an intoxicating substance, illegal drug or prescription drugs, which would affect your ability to safely use firearms, are allowed on the range.
- All firing must be done from the 50 foot firing line. If you wish to have targets closer than 50 ft., mount paper targets on the movable target frames.
- To use movable target frames at less than 50 ft., lower the
- 50 ft. steel target holder (to it's lower position), to avoid accidentally hitting it.
- Horseplay. Running and unnecessary conversations during firing periods are prohibited.
- Violations of these safety rules, or the instructions of a Range Safety Officer may lead to discipline, including but not limited to:
 - Ejection from the range.
 - Suspension of membership
 - Termination of membership
