CLUB RULES

ADMINISTRATIVE RULES:

1. All members *must* sign in on the log sheet by the entrance door.
2. Each member may bring no more than 2 guests during any visit. Members are responsible for their guests and must directly supervise guests while shooting. A person may come as a guest up to two times.
3. Members may not allow others to use their access code.
4. Use of profane or obscene language in the club building is not acceptable.
5. We're trying to make our club a comfortable place for all shooters. Respect one another.
6. The club assumes no responsibility for personal property of its members or guests.
7. For health reasons, no food or drink is allowed in the Rifle Club range area. After shooting or handling cartridges, wash your hands and face with cold water to avoid lead ingestion.

RANGE SAFETY RULES

1. Shooters under 18 years of age may not shoot on the range, unless accompanied by and under the constant supervision of an adult member.
2. No shooter under the age of 10 may fire a rifle on the range unless they have completed an NRA basic rifle course or have obtained a written waiver from the Board of Directors.
3. No shooter under the age of 12 may fire a pistol on the range unless they have completed an NRA basic pistol course or obtained a written waiver from the Board of Directors.
4. No drawing/shooting from a holster, unless done under the supervision of a certified instructor.
5. Cartridge, Firearm, and Ammunition Restrictions:
 - a. On the north side (firing points 13-24), shooters may fire ONLY rifles (no handguns) chambered ONLY in .22 long rifle. No .17 or .22 magnum ammunition allowed. NO EXCEPTIONS!
 - b. No shooting is allowed on the north side (firing points 13-24) unless done under the direct supervision of a team coach, a range safety officer, a certified instructor, or a board member. A violation of this rule is especially serious and will result in immediate termination of membership.
 - c. On the south side (firing points 1-12), shooters may fire any standard pistol cartridge up to .45 caliber, including .17 rimfire and .22 magnum. Both handguns and rifles, chambered in an authorized cartridge/caliber, are allowed.
 - d. To avoid damage to the backstop, no pistol calibers larger than .45 and no rifle cartridges on pistol frames are allowed. If shooting a .44 magnum pistol, please use target loads.
 - e. If you have a firearm chambered in a cartridge not authorized, you may petition the club's board of directors to add it. The board's decision in granting or denying a petition is final.
 - f. No armor piercing or tracer ammunition is allowed.

- g. No fully automatic weapons are allowed.
6. Targets: No steel, reactive, spinning, moving, or other action targets are allowed unless under the direct supervision of a club-designated Range Safety Officer. *Use paper targets only*—use of tin or aluminum cans or glass or plastic containers as targets is strictly prohibited.
7. When Shooting or Handling Firearms:
 - a. Treat all firearms as if they are loaded at all times.
 - b. Always keep the muzzle of your weapon pointed in a “safe direction.” Within the Centralia Rifle Range, this is either downrange or straight up.
 - c. Keep your finger off the trigger until you are ready to fire.
 - d. Eye and ear protection must be worn by all persons on the range, including spectators.
 - e. Follow the orders of the Range Officer, if one is onsite. If no range officer is present, informal groups of shooters should select a person to control their shooting activities.
 - f. No intoxicating substances, nor persons under the influence of an intoxicating substance (legal or illegal), are allowed on the range.
 - g. All firing must be done from the 50-foot firing line. Mount paper targets on the movable target stands. Stands may be no closer than 25 feet from the firing line, which is marked on the floor with red tape. Do not use the metal target stands; they are reserved for use only by the school rifle teams.
 - h. Horseplay of any kind, including running, is prohibited.
 - i. If in a class, always keep your weapon unloaded until you are told to load by the Class Instructor or their designee. Follow all instructions of the instructor.
8. After Shooting:
 - a. Put used targets in the marked container.
 - b. Put brass in the container marked for it. (Put non-brass cartridge cases, i.e. steel and aluminum, in a trash can, *not* the brass bin.)
 - c. Put all other trash into the trash cans. (Empty *trash* cans, when nearly full, into the dumpster outside).
 - d. Sweep up the downrange area, especially target debris. Turn out the range lights; then make sure the entry door shuts and is locked from the outside as you leave. *Please*, don’t sweep anything into the pits at the end of the range—use the appropriate disposal can.
9. Report any damage you cause or observe. If you inadvertently shoot into the vertical or horizontal wooden surfaces, report it the same day by phone to one of the club officers. Phone numbers are by the front door.
10. Range Safety Officers and Instructors have the authority to allow exceptions to these rules on a case-by-case basis.
11. Any violation of any rule, or the instructions of a Range Safety Officer may lead to discipline, including but not limited to: Ejection from the range, suspension of membership, or termination of membership. The club also may pursue legal action for damages. Criminal behavior, including Malicious Mischief, will be reported to the appropriate law enforcement agency.
12. I agree to follow these rules, consisting of two pages, because I want our club to remain a safe place for individuals to shoot without supervision.

READ THIS CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING

I, _____, being _____ years of age, in consideration of the furnishings of facilities, equipment, targets and/or services, including but not limited to instruction in marksmanship by the CENTRALIA RIFLE CLUB, a Washington not-for-profit corporation, (hereinafter referred to as the "CLUB") and the CITY OF CENTRALIA, a municipal corporation, (hereinafter referred to as the "CITY"), agree on behalf of myself, my survivors, my heirs, or assignees to fully and forever release, discharge, indemnify and hold harmless the CLUB, and the CITY, their agents, servants and employees from any and all claims, damages, demands, rights of action or causes of action present or future, whether the same be known, anticipated or unanticipated, which result from or arising out of my use or intended use of the premises, facilities, equipment, services or functions or my participation in any activity on the premises of the CLUB, or the CITY, from my participation in marksmanship instruction or activities conducted by the CLUB, or for my participation in marksmanship instruction or other activities conducted by the CLUB. I further agree that this indemnification and hold harmless agreement shall apply even if my injuries were caused in whole or in part by acts of negligence by the agents, servants or employees of the CLUB, or the CITY, as lessor. _____ (initials)
